

Privacy Policy

1. Introduction

This Privacy Policy explains how Visionaire Capital AG] (“**we**”, “**our**”, or “**us**”) collects, uses, stores, and protects personal data when you access our website (<https://mynebrowser.com/>; “**Website**”), join our waitlist, participate in our community spaces (<https://community.mynebrowser.com/login>, “**Community Hub**”), or otherwise interact with our services.

If you provide information to us about you or any person other than yourself, you must ensure that the data is accurate and that these other people understand how their data will be used, that they have given their permission for you to disclose it to us and for you to allow us, and our service providers, to use it. You are welcome to provide them with a copy of this Privacy Policy.

We are committed to protecting your privacy and handling personal data responsibly and transparently in accordance with applicable data protection laws, including the Swiss Federal Act on Data Protection (FADP) and, where applicable, the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). However, the application of these laws depends on each individual case.

By accessing our Website and Community Hub, joining our Waitlist or using our services, you acknowledge the practices described in this Privacy Policy.

2. Who We Are

3. Information We Collect

Depending on how you interact with our Website, Community Hub and services, we may collect the following categories of information.

Information You Provide:

- email address
- name or username
- social media handles
- community-related information
- messages or communications you send to us
- wallet addresses voluntarily submitted for verification or access purposes

Information Collected Automatically:

- IP address
- browser type and version
- device information
- operating system
- referring pages and URLs
- website usage information
- server log data
- interaction data related to emails or community features

Information From Third-Party Platforms:

If you interact with us through third-party services such as Discord, Telegram, X (formerly Twitter), or other community platforms, we may receive limited account or profile information associated with those services.

4. How We Use Information

We use collected information to:

- operate, maintain, and improve our Website, Community Hub and services
- manage our waitlist and community access
- communicate with users regarding updates, launches, announcements, and related information
- respond to user enquiries
- provide community functionality and moderation
- verify eligibility for optional community features
- improve security and prevent abuse, fraud, or unauthorized access
- protect us from criminal or abusive activity as part of our risk management and corporate government
- comply with legal obligations and enforce legal claims
- analyze and improve the performance and usability of our services
- develop our business

Our services are designed with a privacy-focused approach. We do not sell personal data and do not intentionally share personal data with third parties for advertising purposes.

Certain future features may allow users to voluntarily participate in optional data-sharing or reward-based programs. Participation in any such features would be entirely optional and subject to separate disclosures, permissions, and applicable terms presented at the time of participation.

5. Waitlist and Email Communications

If you join our waitlist or subscribe to updates, we may send you emails related to:

- product updates
- platform announcements
- early access opportunities
- community news
- service-related communications

You may unsubscribe from marketing or update emails at any time using the unsubscribe link included in those communications.

We may retain limited information after unsubscription where necessary to comply with legal obligations or maintain suppression lists.

6. Email Service Provider

We use third-party email and communication service providers, including SendGrid and Amazon Simple Email Service (SES), to manage and deliver email communications.

When you subscribe to our waitlist or receive emails from us, certain information may be processed by these providers on our behalf, including email addresses, technical metadata, and interaction data related to email delivery and engagement.

7. Community Accounts, Progression, and Participation

If you create an account or participate in the Community Hub, we may process information related to your account activity and participation within the platform.

This may include:

- account and profile information
- usernames and linked social accounts
- password
- task completion status
- referral activity and verified referrals
- rank, level, or progression status
- quiz participation and results
- submissions for community tasks or reviews
- wallet verification status
- participation history within community features

Certain tasks or submissions may be reviewed by moderators or administrators for quality assurance, fraud prevention, abuse prevention, spam detection, platform integrity, or community management purposes.

Referral systems and progression systems are designed to detect misuse, duplicate accounts, artificial engagement, spam, or fraudulent activity.

8. Community Platforms, Social Features and Plug-Ins

We may operate or maintain community spaces, social channels, and communication features through third-party platforms and services, including Discord, Telegram, X (formerly Twitter), and similar platforms.

If you interact with us through these services, certain information may be processed, including usernames, profile information, messages, interactions, and participation data.

These platforms may independently collect and process personal data in accordance with their own privacy policies and terms of service. Please find further information on the purpose and scope of data collection and processing by the third-party providers in their respective privacy notices.

We do not use plug-ins on the Website or the Community Hub. If the Website or the Community Hub contain icons from other third-party providers (e.g. Discord, Telegram, X (formerly Twitter), LinkedIn), we only use these for passive linking to the pages of the respective providers.

9. Wallet Verification and Blockchain Features

Wallet connections may be facilitated through third-party wallet providers or wallet connection protocols.

If you voluntarily connect or verify a blockchain wallet, we may process:

- public wallet addresses
- wallet verification status
- wallet-based access permissions
- technical information associated with wallet connections

When you use blockchains, you acknowledge that your wallet address and other data/information provided by your transactions, which are considered personal data if relating to an identified or identifiable natural person, are permanently and publicly stored on-chain, which means such data is publicly available to anyone. Neither we, nor any third party, has any power to delete such data published by its users to the blockchain. If you want to ensure that your privacy rights are not affected in any way, you should not transact on blockchains as certain rights may not be available or exercisable by you or us due to the technological infrastructure of the blockchain.

Please also note that we do not have access to the third-party wallet connected to the Community Hub and that we do not request, access, or store private keys, seed phrases, or recovery phrases..

You hereby release and indemnify us of any liability associated with data that you transferred to the blockchain.

10. Cookies and Similar Technologies

Our Website and the Community Hub may use cookies and similar technologies to:

- ensure proper website functionality
- improve performance and user experience
- analyze website traffic and usage patterns
- maintain security and reliability

By visiting our Website and the Community Hub, we assume that you consent to the use of such techniques. However, depending on the purpose of these cookies, we may ask for your express consent beforehand. You can access your current settings by opening the “Cookies” section on the Website or the Community Hub and you can withdraw your consent under the same link at any time.

11. Legal Basis for Processing

Insofar as we have asked for your consent, we process your data on the basis of this consent. You can withdraw your consent at any time with effect for the future by sending us a written notification (email to legal@mynebrowser.ai). The withdrawal of your consent affects neither the legality of the processing that we carried out before your withdrawal nor the processing of your data on the basis of other processing grounds.

If we do not need your consent, we will not obtain it and we will process your data for other reasons, such as the initiation/execution of a contract or a business relationship with you, a legal obligation, a vital interest of the data subject or another natural person, or to perform a public task. We may also process your personal data if we have a legitimate interest in doing so, which includes, for example, complying with applicable law and marketing our products and services, the interest in better understanding our markets and in safely and efficiently managing and developing our company, including its activities.

12. Data Transfer to Third Parties

We do not sell personal data.

We do not intentionally share personal data with third parties for behavioral advertising or cross-platform advertising purposes.

We may share your personal data with the following categories of recipients:

- service providers and infrastructure providers
- communication and email providers
- analytics or security providers
- community platform providers
- contractual partners
- legal or regulatory authorities where required by law

13. Disclosure of Data Abroad

The data that we collect from you may be transferred to, processed, and stored in, a country outside the European Economic Area (EEA) or Switzerland. In view of the EEA or Switzerland the law in some of those countries may not offer an adequate level of data protection. We only transfer data to these countries when it is necessary for the performance of a contract or for the exercise or defence of legal claims, or if such transfer is based on your explicit consent or subject to safeguards that assure the protection of your data, such as the EU-U.S. Data Privacy Framework, the Swiss-U.S. Data Privacy Framework and/or the Standard Contractual Clauses approved by the European Commission (SCCs), adjusted according to Swiss law, all of the aforementioned if applicable and required..

14. Data Retention

We retain personal data only for as long as reasonably necessary for the purposes described in this Privacy Policy, including legal, operational, security, and compliance purposes. Upon expiry of the applicable retention period, we will securely destroy your data in accordance with applicable laws and regulations.

15. Data Security

We implement reasonable technical and organizational measures intended to protect personal data against unauthorized access, misuse, disclosure, alteration, or destruction.

However, no method of electronic transmission or storage is completely secure, and we cannot guarantee absolute security. We have therefore put in place procedures to deal with any suspected data breach and will notify you and any applicable regulator of a breach where we are legally required to do so.

16. Your Rights

In connection with our processing of your data, you have various rights under applicable data protection law: the right to **information** about how we process which personal data about you, the right to **rectification**, the right to **erasure**, the right to **restriction** of processing, the right to **data portability**, the right to **withdrawal** of a previously given consent, the right to file a **complaint** with the competent data protection authority if you believe that we are not processing your personal data in accordance with data protection requirements, and the right to **object** to a particular processing. However, we ask that you please contact us first if you believe that we are not processing your personal data in accordance with your wishes, so that we can address your concerns and implement appropriate changes.

Please note that we reserve the right to enforce legal restrictions, if necessary, e.g. if we are obliged to store or process certain data, have an overriding interest (insofar as we can invoke such interests) or need the data to assert claims. If the exercise of certain rights involves costs for you, we will inform you in advance. We have already referred to the possibility of withdrawing consent above. It is important to note that exercising these rights may conflict with your contractual obligations and could result in consequences such as early termination of the contract or associated costs. Should this occur, we will inform you in advance, unless this has already been contractually agreed.

Please note that we may need to verify your identity in order to prevent misuse, e.g. by means of a copy of your ID card or passport, unless identification is otherwise possible.

In addition, every data subject has the opportunity to assert their rights in court or to file a complaint with the relevant data protection authority. In Switzerland, the relevant data protection authority is the Federal Data Protection and Information Commissioner (<http://www.edoeb.admin.ch>).

17. Third-Party Links and Services

Our Website, the Community Hub and services may contain links to third-party websites, platforms, or services. Please note that when you use such link, your data such as IP address, personal browser settings, etc., are transmitted to these third parties. We are not responsible for the privacy practices, content, or security of third-party services. Please be aware that the terms of this Privacy Policy do not apply to these third-party services, or to any collection of your data after you click on links to such third-party services. We encourage you to read the privacy notices of every website you visit or service you use. Any links to third-party services are for your convenience and do not signify our endorsement of such third parties or their services.

18. Children's Privacy

We do not knowingly collect personal data from children in violation of applicable law. The Website, the Community Hub and our services are not directed to children and such individuals are not permitted to use the Website, the Community Hub and our services. Certain features or participation in specific community, wallet, referral, ambassador, or reward-related programs may be limited based on age or jurisdiction where required by applicable law.

If we become aware that we have collected personal data from a child without valid parental consent, we will take steps to delete such data without undue delay.

If you have reason to believe that a child has provided data to us, please contact us at legal@mynebrowser.ai. If you are a parent or guardian and believe that your child has provided data, please contact us, and we will take appropriate steps, including deletion of the data where required.
